PRECAUTIONARY BOIL WATER ADVISORY LIFTED

FOR WATER CUSTOMERS IN THE SHORT LINE PUBLIC SERVICE DISTRICT, CLARKSBURG, HARRISON COUNTY, WEST VIRGINIA

The Precautionary Boil Water Advisory that was issued on Tuesday, August 18, 2026, for Short Line Public Service District customers in the following areas: **Back Street, Bluegrass Drive, Centennial Farm Road, Cooperhead Road, Crooked Run Road (2446-2729), Cross Lane, Davis Mountain Road (20 and 185), Flanigan Oaks Drive, Front Street, Greendale Lane, Gregorys Run Road (1090-4850), Hazel Ash Drive, Heron Way, Hickory Heights Drive, Howard Run Road, Isaac Creek Road, Katy Lick Road, Leafy Lane, Lookout Mountain Drive, Lower Lamberts Run Road, Lower Lane, Meadows Edge Road, Ranel Drive, Romrog Way, Ruth Field Drive, Sardis Road, Southern Road, Sunday Drive, Tillday Hill Drive, Turkey Foot Hill Road, and Upper Lamberts Run Road** has been lifted.

Recent testing confirms that Clarksburg Water Board's water meets all standards for drinking and household use. You may now resume using tap water as usual; boiling or using bottled water is no longer needed. Following the recent water disruption, system flushing was conducted to maintain water quality and clarity. As a result, some customers might notice temporary discoloration in their water, which poses no health risk. To help clear any discolored water from your home's pipes, officials recommend running cold water faucets for five to ten minutes.
