Clarksburg Water Board to Host Neighborhood Meetings on Water System Improvements and Lead Line Replacement Project

Clarksburg, West Virginia – The Clarksburg Water Board (CWB) will be hosting three neighborhood outreach meetings in December to discuss the upcoming Water System Improvements and Lead Line Replacement Project. This project, set to begin as early as January 2025, will impact the North View, Stealey, Main Street, Pike Street, Rosebud, and Chestnut Hills neighborhoods.

The CWB invites all affected residents and business owners to attend one of the following meetings to learn more about what to expect during this phase of the project:

- Tuesday, December 10, 2024 at 6 PM – St. James Parish Hall (Gym), 2107 Pride Avenue, Clarksburg, West Virginia
- Wednesday, December 11, 2024 at 6 PM – Robinson Grand Performing Arts Center, 444 West Pike Street, Clarksburg, West Virginia

Affected residents and business owners will receive a postcard with meeting details next week. This project is the first of a three-phased effort to improve the CWB's water system. The CWB will host similar informational meetings when the next phases are ready to move forward.

"We want to make sure our residents and business owners are well-informed about this important project and what it means for their neighborhoods," said Jason Myers, General Manager of the CWB. "We encourage everyone to come out, ask questions, and learn more about the improvements we're making to our water system."
